Pink Ribbon Riders Assistance Program - Information Sheet

What is the Pink Ribbon Riders Assistance Program and who qualifies?

The Pink Ribbon Riders assistance program is a financial assistance program that is made available to both men and women that are currently in treatment for breast cancer.

Patients must live in the states of:

New York, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, North Dakota and Wyoming.

The program has a 2 part application process with items that will need to be attached and mailed in to complete the application.

Part 1 is online and by completing Part 1, the patient will then be promoted to print out part 2.

Important to know:

- 1. All rules to apply are on the www.pinkribbonriders.com website**
- 2. There are 2 parts to the application.**
- 3. Patients must be a US citizen and live in one of the above states.**
- 4. The processing time is 2 to 4 weeks from the time PRR receives the completed application.**
- 5. Patients may apply to two times in a lifetime. One time per year as long as they are in current treatment for breast cancer.**
- 6. Patients receive a \$500.00 gift card when their application is approved. This will be mailed to them and we do not mail to post office boxes.**
