

Who should apply to the Pink Ribbon Riders Patient Assistance Program for help?

1. You must be a man or woman that is in “*current*” treatment for breast cancer and live in one of the states:

*New York *excludes, Long Island and NYC areas.

*Michigan *excludes Detroit Metro area

*Wisconsin

*Minnesota

*Wyoming

*North Dakota

2. You must be in “*current*” treatment for breast cancer.

* Current treatment means you are recently diagnosed with breast cancer and not years out from your diagnosis date and you must be receiving either: chemo, radiation or awaiting surgery.

3. You must be a US citizen and be able to provide proof.

Examples of who we can not help at this time:

- If you live in any other state than listed above. See Pink Ribbon Riders keeps all the money it raises in the states in which we fundraise in.
- If you are not a US Citizen, this is a rule made upon us by our government.
- 2nd time applicants. If you have received from us before, we can only help you one time.

Good things to know:

* The giving is not done by how much you make or don't make, it is based on the persons' with the greatest need.

* Your gift if accepted can be used for gas money, treatments, food, rent, car payments and need you have that is causing you stress during your treatments. The gift is to make one day better in someone's life.
